Notes about photographing your work:

Please take care in photographing your image. Photograph your work outside and take a photo of it in the shade so there are no shadows on the work. Outside is brighter than inside and does not require additional lighting. You can also put your art on a large white piece of paper or foam core. The reflected light from that helps to lighten the work. Try to be careful of telescoping when taking your pictures. This happens when your camera (or cell phone) is not perpendicular to the piece. One side will be slightly wider than the other. Some of this can be corrected with your cell phone after the picture is taken.
