ACADEMIC CLASSES

For students enrolling in high school completion, HiSet Preparation, College and Adult Transitions. Free for Maine residents. Call our office to get started! Topsham/Brunswick: 729-7323 • RSU 1: 443-8255

ALGEBRA/ARITHMETIC

This class is designed to help students who need or want math review for various situations. Individual programming helps students progress at their own pace to earn a math credit in Arithmetic, Algebra, or Life Skills. The class is also helpful for students who need a refresher before taking a college math class or who feel they want to sharpen their skills for everyday use.

CHEMISTRY W/ LAB

This is a laboratory practice class and will satisfy entrance requirements for post-secondary schools and CNA or nursing preparation.

BIOLOGY W/LAB

This activity oriented course deals with the study of life. Biology with a lab is a fast paced offering that will satisfy requirements for most post-secondary schools including those in the medical field. Lab fee and books included in course fee.

U.S. HISTORY

This course in U.S. History will cover selected thematic topics from Colonization to the Cold War Era. Unit work and tests are designed to be done in class. There will be some homework.

CRITICAL READING & WRITING

Critical Reading and Writing is a 1-credit English course for adult students seeking to finish their high school diploma, prepare to take the HiSET reading and writing exams, get ready for college placement tests, or for high school students in jeopardy of not graduating who need to recover English credit.

HISET REMOTE PREP

If your schedule doesn't allow for traditional face-to-face classes then this could be the class for you. Students work independently at their own pace and meet with an instructor via zoom weekly. Students must have a minimal comfort level with technology and have reliable internet access, Class space is limited to 6 students per session.

HISET PREP LAB

Prepare to take the High School Equivalency Test in the five required areas of Reading, Writing, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies. Instructors work one-on-one or in small groups with students to prepare for each test. Classes meet weekly at our Topsham and Bath offices.

ACADEMIC SUCCESS SEMINAR

Are you interested in going to college? Do you want to take an online course that will prepare you to be successful AND award you three college credits? Merrymeeting's Academic Success Seminar is free to adults interested in preparing to attend college. Students must have their own computer and reliable internet access.



ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNING

Our English Language Learning program offers students the chance to build a strong foundation in English through engaging classes that cover essential conversation skills, grammar, sentence structure, spelling, reading comprehension, and writing. Additionally, we focus on life skills such as time management, critical thinking, and teamwork, helping students achieve their academic and career goals through effective communication and problem-solving. We provide a supportive learning environment with both in-person and online classes to accommodate all students' needs and goals.

We offer the following classes for our English Language Learning students:

- Introduction to English: Focus on fundamental language skills, including basic vocabulary, essential grammar, and simple conversational phrases to help students gain confidence in using English in everyday situations.
- Beginner ELL (I & II):Emphasizes building foundational language skills through interactive activities, which include listening, speaking, reading, and writing, with a focus on everyday vocabulary and basic sentence structures to facilitate effective communication.
- Intermediate ELL (I & II): Expands vocabulary, introduces more complex sentence structures, and focuses on conversational skills.
- Advanced ELL: Emphasizes fluency, academic language, and preparation for higher education or workplace communication

Are you between 15 and 19 years of age and want your State of Maine permit to prepare for your driving exam? We offer driver education courses to help build strong, safe, and confident drivers. Students receive an instructional permit after successful completion of the course with a grade of 80 percent or better. Total hours of instruction is 40; 30 classroom and 10 driving. 




SUSAN'S SEWING JOURNEY






